

The pattern

- Creation (Covenant, something good)
- → Fall (it's compromised, broken)
- → Promise (the way forward)
- → Flood (death/re-birth/creation)



Binding of Isaac

Literal meaning: God's promises re-establish

Spiritual meaning: Abraham as a new Adam, Isaac as a proto-Christ, moral meaning of faith/trust; Cross and Resurrection. And so on. **Next time:**
