



CONFIRMATION PAPERWORK

This packet contains all of the paperwork needed for Confirmation and First Holy Communion.

Please follow the checklist below:

- Submit a copy of your baptismal certificate (due now)
 - seal MUST be visible
- Submit Sponsor Form (due December 13th)
- Submit Saint Form (due December 13th)

Note: Sponsor forms may take a few weeks to be completed by their home parishes. Please don't wait until the last minute to finalize this paperwork. Unfinished paperwork may push your Sacramental Reception date to 2025.

The candidate will need one Liturgical Sponsor who will present the candidate for Confirmation. The sponsor should be actively involved in the candidate's life of faith before, during and after Confirmation. Sponsors are to support their candidate during the preparation process through prayer, words of encouragement and attendance when required.

The sponsor cannot be the candidate's mother or father, as they are already responsible for the faith of the candidate.

If the Sponsor is from another Parish Church, that parish may provide a letter of good standing. Please ask that Parish Church to return their letter/form to St. Thomas Aquinas Parish Office at the above address. If parish cannot provide a letter of good standing, then sponsor will need to provide Sacramental documentation themselves.

If a sponsor cannot attend the scheduled celebration, a proxy may be chosen to stand in for the sponsor.

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Every candidate to be confirmed is asked to choose a Confirmation name. Choosing a name signifies that the person being confirmed is becoming a new creation in Christ. The Confirmation name is a powerful symbol. At the Rite of Reception of candidates or at the Rite of Christian Initiation of catechumens, the celebrant will address the candidate or catechumen by that name to show that the candidate is important and that the gift of faith is being offered to him/her as an individual.

In the past it has been the tradition to take the name of a Saint or a holy person who will serve as a role model and intercessor for Confirmation. Since each person is created anew at his/ her Baptism, choosing the same name as one's Baptismal name is absolutely acceptable today. Doing so also emphasizes more clearly the unity which exists between the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. However, choosing the name of a favorite biblical person, beatified individual, or canonized Saint whose Christian lifestyle the candidate or catechumen would like to imitate is perfectly acceptable. Candidates should choose a name that will remind and inspire them to treat others as Christ would.

Picking a name that holds a personal significance for the candidate will help the Confirmation experience be more meaningful for them. For resources on the saints, catholic.org/saints is a good place to start or ask your catechist for help!

We ask that the candidates' first name, middle name or Mary is not used for their Saint Name.
